



The theme of 1991 was “Our Hong Kong, Our Concern” (香港是吾根，關懷情至深) . It was the first time that NOM organized to organize the JCI “PRIME” training programme and 14 members were qualified as the first batch of JCI certified trainers in Hong Kong. We formed An Ad hoc Committee on Training to recommend long-term training strategies. The recommendations made by this Committee were adopted and a “Training Department” for the long term development of training was established and later it has evolved to the current “Training and Development Council”

In the Community Development, we have initiated to organized a large scale theme project called “One plus One, Support election 91” in response to promote civic involvements to support the first Direct Election of the Legislative Council in the history of Hong Kong, in which over 300 high spirited JC members from all the 17 chapters dashed to different districts and locations to promote voting. Mr. Michael Suen, Secretary for Constitutional Affairs and Miss Hong Kong had officiated at the ceremony. The project was well covered by the mass media and this project has enhanced the image and statues of JC in civic involvements.

We also jointly organized the youth event “Youth In Action - 青年行動，我做得好” with other youth or voluntary organizations. Movie Stars and celebrities had taken part in this grand event.

Internationally, I represented Hong Kong in the United Kingdom delegation to attend the “International Model United Nations” organized by JCI and the United Nations from July 28 to August 2 in the UN Headquarters in New York City. The theme was “Age of Global Citizenship”. JC delegates and Non-Governmental Organizations representatives from all over the world took part in the 5-day event. Over 40 resolutions on “Children Future”, “Economic Development” and “Environmental Protection” were adopted and were passed to United Nations and its relevant agencies for consideration and follow up. I was elected as 1992 JCI Asian Pacific Development Council Chairman at the JCI Cebu Asian Pacific Conference while Senator Stephen Chan was appointed as Special Assistant to JCI World Presidents for Finance and Sponsorship in Area B and Senator Connie Chu Lo was elected as the Director of the Asian Pacific Senate Board at the JCI Cebu Asian Pacific Conference.
